The section contains some problematical trace fossils which are currently under investigation, but is mainly of importance for its excellent display of soft-sediment deformation features and turbidite induced scours. Some fine examples of squamiform loading are present and a field of flute marks which ranks as one of the best in the country. A key site for sedimentological studies in the Carboniferous.
