Description and Reasons for Notification:

This locality is vital in representing the only exposure of the Roach Stone, a calcareous sandstone developed in the Fulletby Beds of the Southern Wolds. The site is also significant in having been the source of an interesting brachiopod fauna - and the type locality for three new species. A key Barremian site important in Lower Cretaceous stratigraphic studies.
