1	Cultivation, including ploughing, rotovating, harrowing, and re-seeding.
2	Grazing.
3	Stock feeding.
4	Mowing or other methods of cutting vegetation.
5	Application of manure, fertilisers and lime.
6	Application of pesticides, including herbicides (weedkillers).
7	Dumping, spreading or discharge of any materials.
8	Burning of vegetation.
9	The release into the site of any wild, feral or domestic animal*, plant or seed.
10	The killing or removal of any wild animal* save for legitimate quarry species or recognised pests.
11	The destruction, displacement, removal or cutting of any plant or plant remains, including tree, shrub, herb, hedge, dead or decaying wood, moss, lichen, fungus, leaf-mould, turf or aquatic plant or algae.
12	Tree and/or woodland management+.
13a	Drainage (including the use of mole, tile, tunnel or artificial drains).
13b	Modification of the structure of tidal creeks and channels, rivers, streams, springs, ditches, dykes and drains, including their banks and beds, as by re-alignment, re-grading and dredging.
13c	Management of aquatic and bank vegetation for drainage purposes.
14	The changing of water levels and tables and water utilisation (including irrigation, storage and abstraction from existing water bodies and through boreholes).
15	Infilling of ditches, dykes, drains, ponds, pools, marshes or pits.
16a	The introduction of freshwater fishery production and/or management, including sporting fishing and angling.
16b	The introduction of new coastal fisheries or changes in coastal fishing practice or fisheries management and seafood or marine life collection including the use of traps or fish cages.
17	Reclamation of land from sea, estuary or marsh.
18	Bait digging in intertidal areas.
19	Erection of sea defences or coast protection works, including cliff or landslip drainage or stabilisation measures.
20	Extraction of minerals, including peat, shingle, sand and gravel, topsoil, subsoil, shells and spoil.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying, maintenance or removal of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
22	Storage of materials.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
24	Modification of natural or man-made features, including sea walls, clearance of boulders, large stones, loose rock, shingle or spoil and battering, buttressing or grading or seeding of rock-faces, out crops, cuttings, beaches and foreshores.

- 25 Removal of geological specimens, including rock samples, minerals and fossils.
- 26 Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb vegetation, fauna or features of interest.
- 27 Recreational or other activities likely to damage vegetation, fauna or features of interest.
- 28 Changes in game and waterfowl management and hunting practice.

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\* 'animal' includes any mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird, fish or invertebrate.

+ including afforestation, planting, clear and selective felling, thinning, coppicing, modification of the stand or underwood, changes in species composition, cessation of management.
