2	The introduction of grazing and changes in the grazing regime (including type of stock or intensity or seasonal pattern of grazing).
3	The introduction of stock feeding and changes in stock feeding practice, including changes in the number of animals stocked.

6	Application of pesticides, including herbicides (weedkillers).
7	Dumping, spreading or discharge of any materials.
8	Burning.
9	The release into the site of any wild, feral or domestic animal*, plant or seed.
11	The destruction, displacement, removal or cutting of aquatic or shoreline vegetation.
12	The introduction of tree or woodland management+ and changes in tree and/or woodland management+.
13a	Drainage (including the use of mole, tile, tunnel or other artificial drains).
13b	Modification of the structure of watercourses (eg streams, springs, ditches, dykes, drains), including their banks and beds, as by re-alignment, re-grading and dredging.
13c	Management of aquatic and bank vegetation for drainage purposes (see also 11).
14	The changing of water levels and tables and water utilisation (including irrigation, storage and abstraction from existing water bodies and through boreholes), with the exception of abstraction for spray irrigation in accordance with the existing licence.
15	Infilling of ditches, dykes, drains, pools, or marshes.
16a	Changes in freshwater fishery production and/or management**.
20	Extraction of minerals, including peat, sand and gravel, topsoil, subsoil, chalk, lime and spoil.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying, maintenance or removal of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
22	Storage of materials.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb features of interest.
27	Recreational or other activities likely to damage aquatic or shoreline vegetation or breeding wildfowl.
28	Changes in game and waterfowl management and hunting practice.
