1	Cultivation, including ploughing, rotovating, harrowing, and re-seeding or other direct disturbance of vegetation.
2	The introduction of grazing and changes in the grazing regime (including type of stock or intensity or seasonal pattern of grazing).
3	The introduction of stock feeding and changes in stock feeding practice.
4	The introduction of mowing or cutting or changes in the mowing or cutting regime (including hay-making to silage).
5	Application of manure, livestock slurry, fertilisers and lime.
6	Application of pesticides, including herbicides (weedkillers).
7	Dumping, spreading or discharge of any materials.
8	Burning and changes in the pattern or frequency of burning.
9	The release into the site of any wild, feral or domestic animal*, plant or seed.
10	The killing or removal of any wild animal*, including pest control.
11	The destruction, displacement, removal or cutting of any plant or plant remains, including tree, shrub, herb, hedge, dead or decaying wood, reed and turf.
12	The introduction of tree and/or woodland management+ or changes in tree and/or woodland management+.
13a	Drainage (including the moor-gripping, the use of mole, tile, tunnel or other artificial drains).
13b	Modification of the structure of watercourses (eg streams, ditches, dykes), including their banks and beds, as by re-alignment, re-grading and dredging.
13c	Management of aquatic and bank vegetation for drainage purposes (see also 11).
14	The changing of water levels and tables and water utilisation (including irrigation, storage and abstraction from existing water bodies and through boreholes).
15	Infilling of ditches, dykes, drains, ponds, pools, marshes or other water bodies.
16a	The introduction of freshwater fishery production and/or management**.
17	Reclamation of land from marsh.
19	Erection of sea defences or coast protection works, including stabilisation measures.
20	Extraction of minerals, including topsoil and sub-soil, clay and spoil.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
22	Storage of materials.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
24	Modification of natural or man-made features.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb features of interest.
27	Recreational or other activities likely to damage or disturb vegetation or wildlife.
28	Introduction of game or waterfowl management and changes in game and waterfowl management and hunting practice.

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\* 'animal' includes any mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird, fish or invertebrate.

+ including afforestation, planting, clear and selective felling, thinning, coppicing, modification of the stand or underwood, changes in species composition.

\*\* including sporting, fishing and angling.
