1	Cultivation, including ploughing, rotovating, harrowing, and re-seeding.
2	The introduction of grazing and changes in the grazing regime, including type of stock or intensity or seasonal pattern of grazing and cessation of grazing.
3	The introduction of stock feeding and changes in stock feeding practice.
4	The introduction of mowing or other methods of cutting vegetation and changes in the mowing or cutting regime, including hay making to silage and cessation.
5	Application of manure, fertilisers and lime.
6	Application of pesticides, including herbicides (weedkillers).
7	Dumping, spreading or discharge of any materials.
8	Burning and changes in the pattern or frequency of burning.
9	The release into the site of any wild, feral or domestic animal*, plant or seed.
10	The killing or removal of any wild animal*, including pest control.
11	The destruction, displacement, removal or cutting of any plant or plant remains.
13a	Drainage, including moor-gripping and the use of mole, tile, tunnel or other artificial drains.
13b	Modification of the structure of watercourses (eg rivers, streams, springs, ditches, dykes, drains), including their banks and beds, as by re-alignment, re-grading and dredging.
13c	Management of aquatic and bank vegetation for drainage purposes.
15	Infilling of ditches, dykes, drains, ponds, pools, marshes or pits.
16b	Changes in coastal fishing practice or fisheries management and seafood or marine life collection, including the use of traps or fish cages.
17	Reclamation of land from sea, estuary or marsh.
18	Bait digging in inter-tidal areas.
19	Erection of sea defences or coast protection works, including cliff or landslip drainage or stabilisation measures.
20	Extraction of minerals, including shingle, sand and gravel, shells, topsoil and subsoil.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying, maintenance or removal of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb features of interest.
27	Recreational or other activities likely to damage features of interest such as saltmarsh and mudflats physically or by disturbance to wildlife.
28	Introduction of or changes in waterfowl management.

* 'animal' includes any mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird, fish or invertebrate.
