1	Cultivation, including ploughing, rotovating, harrowing, and re-seeding.

10	The killing or removal of any wild animal*.
11	The destruction, displacement or removal of any plant.
12	Changes in tree or woodland management+.
13a	Drainage (including the use of mole, tile, tunnel or other artificial drains).
14	The changing of water levels and tables and water utilisation (including irrigation, storage and abstraction from existing water bodies and through boreholes).
15	Infilling of ditches, pools or pits.
20	Extraction of minerals, including sand and gravel, clay, topsoil or sub-soil.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying, maintenance or removal of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
22	Storage of materials.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb features of interest.
27	Recreational activities likely to damage the trees or turf.
28	Changes in game management.

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\* 'animal' includes any mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird, fish or invertebrate.
