1	Cultivation, including ploughing, rotovating, harrowing, and re-seeding.

10	The killing or removal of any wild bat*.

23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
24	Modification of natural or man-made features (including cave entrances) clearance of boulders, large stones and battering, buttressing or grading rock-faces and cuttings, infilling of pits and quarries.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb features of interest.
27	Recreational or other activities likely to damage caves or disturb bat roosts.

* 'animal' includes any mammal, reptile, amphibian, bird, fish or invertebrate.
