15	Infilling of ditches or drains.
20	Extraction of minerals, including topsoil, subsoil and lime.
21	Construction, removal or destruction of roads, tracks, walls, fences, hardstands, banks, ditches or other earthworks, or the laying, maintenance or removal of pipelines and cables, above or below ground.
22	Storage of materials.
23	Erection of permanent or temporary structures, or the undertaking of engineering works, including drilling.
26	Use of vehicles or craft likely to damage or disturb the flora and fauna.
27	Recreational or other activities likely to damage the flora and fauna.
28	The introduction of or changes in game management and hunting practice.
